According to Joe Martin, Code Enforcement Officer, permits must be issued and fees paid prior to construction in the City of Berlin. Applications can be picked up at the Code Enforcement Office at 220 Main Street (Basement of the old court house). Because most permits need the approval of the Fire Department, Zoning Officer and the Building Inspector, it can take up to a week for a permit to be issued after the receipt of the application.
