The Superintendent informed the Board on the pros and cons of the upcoming school vacation. She reported that a survey was sent to the staff and the results were split. She also discussed how it was important to keep on the same schedule as Gorham and presented a compromise to have school vacation continue as a minimized vacation allowing for staff, students, and parents to have a break but still continue to provide a routine of remote learning and meal distribution.
