BAA's Right to First Refusal on McMann Hangar

Commissioner Gentili moved with a second from Commissioner Rozek that the Berlin Airport Authority waive its right to first refusal on hangar #5 in Area B owned by Charles McMann. So moved, the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Grenier mentioned that there are ATV enthusiasts who have contacted the airport about storing their atv at the airport. They would then fly in to go riding. Mr. Hamel will make one of his hangars available for this use.

Mr. Leveille commented that this will be a good thing for the airport because it is an opportunity to sell fuel.
