Berlin Police and Fire Departments COVID-19 Procedures

Policies 1 through 4 are administrative policies which are provided for your information. These policies are in place and may be modified as the COVID-19 response evolves.

Policy 5 incorporates the provisions of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act which establishes two weeks of paid "COVID sick leave" at 2/3'rds pay. The Act gives the employer the option of exempting first responders and other critical positions from the sick leave provision. From an employee equity standpoint and given our local circumstances, I am recommending that we do not exclude or exempt any employees from this provision. Accordingly, the yellow highlight on the attached policy reflects this. Given that this is an employee benefit which could incur cost, the Council should vote on this provision.

Finally, also included is the <u>Berlin Police and Fire Departments COVID-19 Procedures.</u> This document is meant to provide specific, comprehensive information for our first responders.

All of these documents have been produced collaboratively by COVID-19 Task Force members with input from the Health Officer, and where applicable, have received legal review.
