AN ORDINANCE amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Chapter 15 , TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE III. STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, Sec. 15-33. Stop Intersections by adding a Stop sign on Memorial Lane as it intersects with Madison Avenue

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Berlin, as follows:

That Sec. 15-33. is hereby amended by adding the designation depicted below.

Sec. 15-33. Stop Intersections.

- (a) Any person operating a vehicle on a street upon which a stop sign has been placed by authority of the mayor and city council shall bring such vehicle to a complete stop before crossing the line of pedestrian traffic on such street. The following streets and squares are designated as stop streets:

Memorial Lane, as it intersects with Madison Avenue

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
