AN ORDINANCE amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Chapter 9, LICENSING, ARTICLE V. PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, ITINERANT VENDORS, Sec. 9-163. Winery, Beverage Manufacturer, Brewpub and Nano-Brewery Sales at Farmer's Markets

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Berlin, as follows:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.

That Sec. 9-163 is added to Chapter 9 as depicted below.

Sec. 9-163. Winery, Beverage Manufacturer, Brewpub and Nano-Brewery Sales at Farmer's Markets
Any individual or organization falling under Sec. 9-151 or Sec. 9-152 above who classifies as a winery,
beverage manufacturer, brewpub or nano-brewery as defined in Title XIII: Alcoholic Beverages of the
NHRSAs, may sell products that they manufacture, in closed containers, at duly authorized farmer's markets
within the City after complying with all applicable rules of the NH Liquor Commission.
