A RESOLUTION authorizing the Berlin Police Commission to apply for and accept \$5,110.84 (Five Thousand, One Hundred Ten Dollars and Eighty-Four Cents) in grant funds from the NH Department of Safety for the purpose of effectuating the Homeland Security Exercise & Evaluation Program (HSEEP).

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:

WHEREAS the safety of Berlin's citizens is imperative; and

WHEREAS terrorist activity remains a viable threat; and

WHERAS the State of New Hampshire, Department of Homeland Security recognizes this threat and is taking measures in preparation of meeting such threats; and

WHEREAS the Department of Homeland Security has grant funding available to conduct training exercises designed to test planning, communications, and interoperability for events necessitating a multi-jurisdictional response; and

WHEREAS participation in said exercises will enhance response capabilities as well as highlight areas that need improvement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Berlin, NH, that the Berlin Police Commission is authorized to apply for and receive grant funds from the NH Department of Safety for the purpose of effectuating said Homeland Security Exercise & Evaluation Program. Further, upon receipt of the grant, the sum of \$5,110.84 (Five Thousand One Hundred Ten Dollars and Eighty-Four Cents) is hereby appropriated to the Berlin Police Department Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, in addition to all previously-appropriated funds.
