A RESOLUTION accepting and appropriating Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) from the Neil and Louise Tillotson Fund of the NH Charitable Foundation to hire a consultant to study the development of an independent school administrative unit to include an analysis of the legal and other process steps required to do so

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:

Whereas, the Berlin City Council passed Resolution 2017-16 recognizing the need to study, evaluate and consider potential changes to the current School Administrative Unit governance as a direct dependent department of the City along with considerations for broader regionalization of the school systems of the area for the purpose of maintaining, improving and creating a sustainable education system for the youth of the area; and

Whereas, the Neil and Louise Tillotson Fund has made \$35,000 available to fund the study.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council accepts Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) from the Neil and Louise Tillotson Fund of the NH Charitable Foundation to hire a consultant to study the development of an independent school administrative unit to include an analysis of the legal and other process steps required to do so and appropriates such funds for the purpose of the grant.

Be it further resolved that the City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate the grant.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
