A RESOLUTION authorizing an application to the New Hampshire Preservation Alliance for an assessment grant in the amount of \$4,500.00 to hire a consultant to review and assess the structural and historical conditions of the Berlin Public Library.

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:

Whereas, the Berlin Public Library is nearly 120 years old and is one of only a few remaining Carnegie Libraries in NH that are still in use; and

Whereas, the NH Preservation Alliance makes monies available to help evaluate and assess the conditions of historic properties in NH; and

Whereas, the library is in need of several repairs and upgrades to its mostly original features; and

Whereas, upon approval, the City Manager is authorized to receive said grant and the grant proceeds are hereby appropriated for the purpose of the grant; and

Whereas, all grant proceeds shall be deposited with the City Treasurer and that any additional use of these funds beyond the scope of work as listed in the application shall require prior approval of the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes an application to the New Hampshire Preservation Alliance for an assessment grant in the amount of \$4,500.00 to hire a consultant to review and assess the structural and historical conditions of the Berlin Public Library and appropriates such funds for the purpose of the grant.

Be it further resolved that the City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate the grant.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
