**A RESOLUTION** accepting and appropriating Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) from the Domino's "Paving for Pizza Program" for use filling potholes in the City.

## Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:

Whereas, Berlin streets are adversely affected by freezing and thawing that occurs during Fall and Winter in Northern New Hampshire causing several potholes on City streets; and

Whereas, Domino's Paving for Pizza Program has offered the City \$5,000 for repairing potholes; and

Whereas, the Mayor and City Council recognize that Berlin citizens nominated the City to receive the funding from "Paving for Pizza Program" and they acknowledge that an additional \$5,000 will contribute to smoother roadways in the City.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Berlin, NH accepts a donation of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) from the Paving for Pizza Program to be deposited in Revenue Account #30-366-603-6027 and appropriates said funds for the repair of potholes, Expense Account #30-402-631-6027.

Be it further resolved that the City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate the donation.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
