**A RESOLUTION** accepting a grant from the NH Department of Safety, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management in the amount of Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$9,999.75) to update the City's Hazard Mitigation Plan.

## Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:

Whereas, the City's Hazard Mitigation Plan has not been updated since July of 2016; and

Whereas, the NH Department of Safety has funding available to assist with the update of the City's Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, it is estimated that the total cost of the update will be \$12,499.69 of which the City will pay \$2,499.94 of in kind services and the grant will pay \$9,999.75.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, by the Mayor and City Council that a grant in the amount of \$9,999.75 is accepted from the NH Department of Safety, and appropriated to the Berlin Fire Department to update the City's Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Be it further resolved that the terms of the grant agreement are accepted as presented and the City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate the grant.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
