A RESOLUTION authorizing the Berlin Airport Authority to apply for and accept a grant for \$261,993.35 from the Federal Aviation Administration for "Apron & Stub Taxiway Pavement Maintenance, Overlay, Markings and Area Lighting Improvements" at the Berlin Regional Airport

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:

Whereas, funding for the project is available through the Federal Aviation Administration, and

Whereas, the project includes pavement preservation, with full depth crack repair and a 1 inch pavement overlay; pavement markings and area lighting improvements on the airport's taxiway, and

Whereas, the Berlin Airport Authority reviewed the project and the options at their September 21, 2020 meeting; and

Whereas, the Berlin Regional Airport will be responsible for \$6,985.65 of the total project costs, which will be paid for by the Berlin Airport Capital Improvement Budget; and

Whereas, the grant from the FAA will pay \$261,993.35 and the Berlin Airport will be responsible for \$6,985.65 which is 3% of the project costs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

That the Berlin Airport Authority is authorized to apply for and receive \$261,993.35 of grant funds from the Federal Aviation Administration for "Apron & Stub Taxiway Pavement Maintenance, Overlay, Markings and Area Lighting Improvements" at the Berlin Regional Airport and upon receipt, these funds are hereby appropriated to the Airport Fund.

Be it further resolved that the Chair of the Berlin Airport Authority, Paul Grenier, is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate the grant.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
