



In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty One

A RESOLUTION authorizing: the re-appropropriation of funds in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) in order to fund rehabilitation work on the Mason Street Bridge.

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council authorized the borrowing of One Million, One Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$1,100,000.00) in Resolution 2020-16 for improvements to the Berlin Fire Station and resurfacing of a section of Hutchins St. ; and

WHEREAS, the work on Hutchins St. was completed under the estimated budget resulting in a surplus; and

WHEREAS, the City received a bid for construction on April 29, 2021 to complete a portion of needed rehabilitation work on the Mason St. Bridge in the amount of \$564,385 and construction administration is estimated to cost \$50,000.00 for a total estimated cost of \$614,385; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and City Council intend to appropriate the balance of funds needed to do the bridge project in the FY22 Budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council hereby authorize and approve the re-appropropriation of funds in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) in order to fund rehabilitation work on the Mason Street Bridge.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
