A RESOLUTION authorizing the acceptance of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds from the Coos County Delegation in the amount of \$250,000.00 to be use for the engineering and design of water & sewer infrastructure on NH Route 110 and, upon approval, appropriated to Fund 30 for use by the City of Berlin as described herein to the FY2022 City Budget.

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:

Whereas, the Coos County Delegation has allocated funds to Coos County town for eligible projects; and

Whereas, investment in water and sewer infrastructure is an eligible use of funding; and

Whereas, water and sewer infrastructure does not currently extend beyond the City's pumping station at 200 Jericho Road; and

Whereas, extending water and sewer infrastructure in this area will open up the corridor for both commercial and residential development, which first needs to be designed and these funds are critical to getting the work done quickly.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Berlin, NH that funding from American Rescue Plan Act is accepted from the Coos County Delegation in the amount of \$250,000.00 for the purpose of developing engineering and design plans for the extension of water & sewer infrastructure on NH Route 110 and upon approval to be appropriated to Fund 30 for use by the City of Berlin in FY2022 City Budget.

Be it further resolved that the City of Berlin accepts the terms of the grant and grant agreement as presented and that the City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate the grant.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
