**A RESOLUTION** authorizing the acceptance of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds from the Coos County Delegation in the amount of \$200,000.00 to be use for the design and construction of a salt shed for the Public Works Department and, upon approval, appropriated to Fund 30 for use by the City of Berlin as described herein

## Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:

Whereas, the Coos County Delegation has allocated funds to Coos County town for eligible projects; and

Whereas, investment in City infrastructure is an eligible use of funding; and

Whereas, the City has been discussing the need for a new salt shed structure for many years; and

Whereas, construction of this new structure will alleviate many existing issues related to the current storage configuration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Berlin, NH that funding from American Rescue Plan Act is accepted from the Coos County Delegation in the amount of \$200,000.00 for the purpose of the design and construction of salt shed for the Public Works Department and upon approval to be appropriated to Fund 30 for use by the City of Berlin.

Be it further resolved that the City of Berlin accepts the terms of the grant and grant agreement as presented and that the City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate the grant.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
