**A RESOLUTION** accepting a grant in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) from the Neil and Louise Tillotson Fund – DASH Grant of the NH Charitable Foundation to support the development of a racial equity policy.

**Resolved by the City Council of the City of Berlin as Follows:**

Whereas, the City of Berlin has received a large federal grant from the US Department of Transportation; and

Whereas, the majority of federal grants are requiring communities to have policies in place around racial equity, climate justice, and labor & work as well as other performance measures; and

Whereas, this policy needs to be implemented before any construction starts related to the RAISE grant; and

Whereas, the City does not have a racial equity policy in place; and

Whereas, the NH Center for Justice & Equity is willing to help put together such a policy but there are costs related to this work; and

Whereas, the DASH Grant program provides up to \$2000.00 each calendar year to North Country Organizations for projects and we were successful in receiving funds to assist us in this work.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Berlin, NH that a grant in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) from the Neil and Louise Tillotson Fund – DASH Grant of the NH Charitable Foundation is hereby accepted and appropriated for the purpose of the grant.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after passage.
