Subject: No right on red

Members of the Traffic Safety Committee, The City Council as a whole, and The Honorable Mayor Paul Greiner,

Currently, at the intersection of Pleasant street and Mason street there is a no right on red restriction while traveling south and east. While this restriction may have been needed when there were buildings impeding the view of incoming traffic, these obstacles are no longer present. I propose that the restrictions be lifted to allow for traffic to make a right on red after stop while traveling both south and east. I recommend that the lanes be changed as follows: while traveling south, the left lane is currently a left turn only lane and the right lane is right turns and straight. I believe that it would be most efficient to change the left lane into a left turn and straight lane and change the right lane into right turns only. The layout for traffic traveling east will have to remain the same due to their only being one lane.
