Honorable Mayor, Members of the City Council,

I wish to thank you for allowing me to submit these supporting documents before you on September 16th, well beyond the appeal process deadline. I was unaware of the high sewer bill until reading the letter from the citys accounting firm on September 4th. Enclosed find a letter from the Berlin Water Works superintendent dated September 5th stating that a technician from his department was sent out to meet me at the property in January 2018 to shut off the water service and he further states, "They found that the water meter had frozen and split, causing the water to spill out on to the basement floor, and did not drain through the city sewer system."

I would like to add that on the advice of the technician that replaced my water meter I did not open the valves inside the house until I had a plumber present and on September 4th with Northwoods Heating present Jim Welsh informed me that he was not a plumber and so the valves remain closed to this day. I am scheduled to have the service shut off at the street on September 19th due to the extreme strain this has put on my finances and wished to point out that if any of the above facts needed verification that technician could verify and observe that the RV antifreeze still remains in the toilet bowl and trap. In the Spring I will be in a position to address these plumbing and heating issues as I am on a fixed income of SS and a pension. With the knowledge gained the hard way I would not anticipate troubling the Council again in the future.
