Subject: Veterans Memorial Park

To: Berlin City Council

At our VFW meeting on October 21, 2020 we established a committee to manage the realignment of monuments at Veterans Memorial Park. Members of this committee are Maurice Mailhot , Chairman, and Peter McGillen. Over the last three months , Mr. Mailhot has taken measurements of the park and established appropriate locations for the monuments. He and Mr McGillen have met with a number of local business owners, explained our plans to improve Veterans Park and were met with a great deal of enthusiasm. Winter had slowed our project, but has given us time to plan. With your approval, we hope to have everything in order to move forward in the spring.. Listed below is our proposal.

1. Mr. Mailhot will donate a new Veterans Memorial Park sign 72" X 24" and place it eight feet from the edge of the sidewalk. The sign will be made of New Hampshire Granite.
2. The second project will be relocate the Civil War Monument from its current location next to the gazebo to a point 19' behind the Veterans Memorial Park sign. Mr. Donald Piper has agreed to assist us with the move.
3. The third project is more complicated. We want to relocate the Spanish American Monument for the East Side next to the skate park and place it 19' behind the Civil War Monument. To accomplish this difficult task, we need to find a suitable rock to replace the existing one. Then remove the Eagle and name plate from the old rock and place it on the rock at Veterans Memorial Park. There is a chance the existing stone can be moved in tact.
