Re: City Manager's Report

1. Attached is the State biennial bridge inspection report for bridges in the City. The Hillside Avenue Bridge is due to be replaced this summer. Postings on the SL & ARR Bridge over Willow Street will have new posting put up with the correct height listed. The Mason Street Bridge over the canal has been classified E2 until it can be further evaluated.
2. As authorized by the Council at the last meeting, a letter was sent to Clint Savage asking to extend the OHRV trail west .3 of a mile on Jericho Road. A copy of the letter is attached.
3. The City was provisionally awarded Community Development Block Grant Feasibility funding for the snow melt project in the amount of \$12,000 pending the submission of additional information to the CDBG staff.
4. The fuel distribution project is out to bid with bids due January 26th. As you may recall, we are under an administrative order by consent to permanently close the tanks at the public works garage in accordance with DES rules. While under construction, the City will be using a card system to obtain fuel at local fueling stations for its needs.
5. The multi-unit residential building at Rockingham St. has been demolished and debris has been removed from the site. Final site restoration remains to be completed.
6. Departmental reports attached for you review include:
 - Fire
 - Police
 - Public Works

7. A series of three House bills HB254, HB323 and HB 324 are aimed at diminishing the authority of the Assessing Standards Board. It is clear that these pieces of legislation originated from advocates of the utilities. The first seeks to remove assessors (and assessing expertise) from the ASB. The second transfers much of the authority of the ASB to the Commissioner of the DRA. The third removes the authority of municipalities to assess utilities and for utility values to be based solely on the DRA 83-F values determined for the purpose of equalization. We will need to track each of these as they progress in the legislative process.

Re: Extending OHRV Use on Jericho Road 0.3 of a Mile West


Dear Clint:

The City of Berlin and the entire North Country have benefited economically as we welcome OHRV enthusiasts to Coos County. Berlin has seen development on Jericho Road (Rte. 110) which includes a campground a deli/bakery and several in process land investments we expect to lead to more economic activity.

On behalf of the NH Bureau of Trails you approached the City with a request to extend OHRV use on Route 110 a distance of 0.3 of a mile from the current trail on Rte. 110, at the intersection of St. Laurent Lane, in a westerly direction. This is within the 40 mile per hour speed limit zone. With a positive recommendation from the City Council Traffic Safety Committee, the City Council voted at their January 9, 2017 meeting to authorize me to send this letter supporting the extension.



Please note if there are any changes in the recommended weight posting or lack of postings for your bridges. Even though a bridge may be recommended for a weight posting or closure by the State, the decision to properly post or close the structure is the responsibility of the municipal officials. It is in the best interest of the municipality to post or sign your bridges in accordance with these recommendations. A failure to warn motorists of potential bridge hazards could result in tort liability claims. Also, if your bridges are not posted properly, it will result in forfeiture of any possible federal highway funds for projects in your municipality. Please note that we understand that Bridge # 256/057, 12th Street over Androscoggin River has been under construction. An updated inspection report will follow once the bridge has been completed and inspected.

Our bridge inspectors have indicated that you have one bridge with incorrect posting signs (*see italicized note*). As required by Federal law, this deficiency will be reported to the Federal Government. All Federally funded municipal projects in your municipality will have funds withheld until deficiencies are corrected. Please advise when these signs have been corrected so we can notify the Federal Government of your compliance to our recommendations. Please call if there are any questions.
