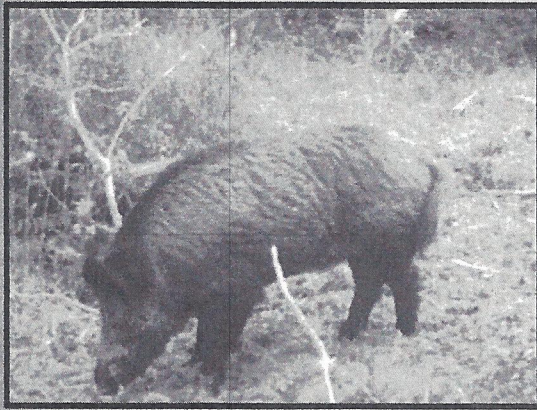

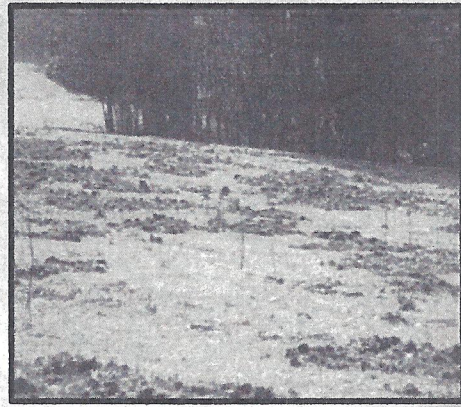

Re: City Manager's Report

1. There is a bid out for the Napert Pump Station Control Panel Replacement that is due December 13th. This project is in the budget and will be funded by the Sewer Fund.
2. As indicated in my last report, a Request for Proposals for an update to the City's Emergency Operations Plan is advertise and is due December 20th. Upon review of the proposals and identification of the successful respondent, we will come to the Council with a resolution for grant funds to update the plan.
3. The United States Department of Agriculture, Wildlife Services – NH) is reaching out to towns in New Hampshire asking them to post data to encourage citizens to report any sightings of feral swine. REPORT all sightings and activity to the USDA, APHIS, Wildlife Services at: (603)-223-6832. The poster supplied by USDA Wildlife Services is attached.
4. Registration is open until December 12th for the 3rd to 6th Grade Ski and Snowboard Program. Lessons are at Wildcat Mountain and have a fee of \$100 for lessons; \$50.00 additional fee if renting equipment. Register at the Recreation Center.
5. Just a reminder that Dan Wilson of Wilson Engineering Services will be at next week's City Council Meeting to review the completed Snow-Melting System Feasibility Study. In recognition that such a project, if pursued, will likely require support from our Federal delegation, I have invited representatives from our delegation to attend the presentation. Also invited is the Main St. Program, BIDPA members and the Chamber of Commerce.

FERAL SWINE

- Feral Swine damage pasture, lawns and consume and trample crops
- Feral Swine devastate natural habitat and will out-compete native wildlife for food
- Feral Swine may prey upon amphibians, reptiles, deer fawns, wild turkeys, grouse, and other ground nesting birds and their eggs
- Feral Swine can transmit as many as 30 different pathogens and 37 parasites - many of which pose threats to humans, livestock, wildlife, and pets
- Feral Swine wallowing can contaminate water sources with parasites and bacteria such as giardia, salmonella, and pathogenic E. coli that may be transmitted to humans and animals
