Re: City Manager's Report

- 1. Chief Lacasse reports that Berlin will take part in a POD (Point of Dispensing) exercise on Saturday, April 13th from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Berlin High School. The exercise is being planned and will be run in conjunction with the Health Consortium. Fire, State Police and EMS will participate. There will be state officials present to observe and assess the response. If any Council member would like to observe, we can arrange for this with the Fire Chief.
- 2. Attached is a short communication, from the Fire Chief, which was requested at the FD Budget meeting. The memo lists the current ISO ratings.
- 3. FCI Berlin has contacted us about re-initiating the city Beautification project. They are hoping to be able to provide us with 5 personnel who will be supervised by PWD staff.
- 4. Reminder that there will be a Right to Know Workshop presented by the NH Municipal Association Wednesday, April 3 at the High School Library beginning at 6:30 p.m. Preregistration is required at https://nhmunicipal.wufoo.com/forms/righttoknow-law-governmental-meetingsberlin/.
- 5. Reminder to, join your fellow residents, neighbors, and friends as the City starts work with Camoin Associates to develop a comprehensive economic development strategy. This event will be held on Thursday April 4th at the White Mountains Community College from 6pm-7:30pm. Refreshments will be available.
- 6. Sealed Bids for Airport Improvements at the Airport will be received until April 12, 2019 at 2:00 p.m. The project consists of rehabilitation of Runway 18-36 and airfield sign improvements. Runway rehabilitation will consist of crack filling, crack repairs, and new runway markings. If funding allows, an emulsified asphalt sealcoat will be applied to the runway surface once the crack filling and repairs are complete.
- 7. Berlin's Parking Ban has been extended through April 15th in an ounce of caution and anticipation of a snow event that was predicted for the weekend as well as more potential snow over the next several days.

8. The 2019 Easter "Eggstravaganza" will be held Saturday, April 13 in the Berlin Recreation gymnasium. The gym will be filled with treats as well as books thanks to donations from Wireless Zone and Badger Realty. The event is free but donations are welcomed. Participants and enter a raffle for a large basket of gifts sponsored by Wireless Zone. Each child may select one book thanks in part to Badger Realty. The event is for children ages 2 - 10.
