Re: City Manager's Report

1. Just a reminder that Eric Grenier, our new Public Works Director and Shelli Fortin, our new City Clerk will both start on October 1st.
2. The election results for the Primary held on September 11th, 2018 are attached. There were 855 Democratic ballots, 390 Republican ballots and 16 Libertarian ballots cast. Summary sheets for each party are attached.
3. The Recreation Department is currently offering fall soccer and sign-ups for hockey is going on as well.
4. Construction work on the skate park began today. The Public Works Dept. and Berlin Water Works are working together on the City's in-kind portion of the project which involves performing a majority of the earthwork.
5. Last week, Jason Ross, PE of HEB and I inspected the underside of the Mason St. Bridge. The degradation that we are monitoring has not gotten dramatically worse since last year. We will continue to monitor it until we are able to undertake the repair work. We also reviewed the bridge travel surface and bridge joint and noted work that should be done on the surface soon.
6. Next Friday, September 21st I will be attending the Municipal Management Association of NH Meeting in Concord. In addition to the regular business of the Association there will be a presentation on the workforce shortage in NH as well as the lack of affordable housing.

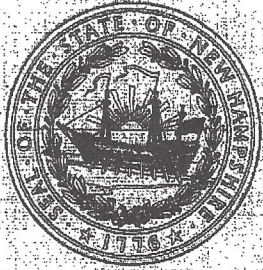

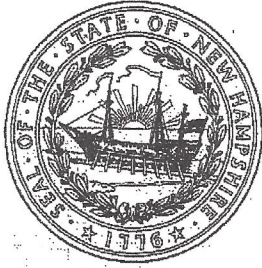
