1. Set of engineered plans showing the lot and buildings to be served and the layout, locations and depths, or elevations of existing piping and underground structures and the proposed sewer piping and other appurtenant structures (manholes, clean-outs, grease traps, etc. as applicable).

NOTE: Hardcopy plans must be submitted in addition to digital plan upload if requested.

I agree to comply with all other provisions of Chapter 16 of the City of Berlin Codified Ordinance entitle "Operation of the Sanitary Sewer System" including, but not limited to the following:

16-71 All cost and expenses incidental to the installation and connection of the building sewer shall be borne by the Owner. The Owner shall indemnify the City from any loss or damage that may directly or indirectly be occasioned by the installation of the building sewer.

16-74 The size, slope, alignment, materials of construction of a building sewer, and the methods to be used in excavating, placing of the pipe, joining, testing, and back-filling of the trench, shall all conform to the requirements of the building and plumbing code or other applicable rules or regulations of the City and shall be approved by the Director of Public Works.

In addition, the undersigned agrees to obtain and pay for all other construction permits and licenses as required.

Permission for the above described construction is granted subject to the instructions, regulations and conditions of this agreement.
