ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION PHASING

- **Phase I** Mill and Overlay (Twelfth St. north)
- **Phase II** Full Reconstruction (Seventh Eighth St. and Twelfth St. intersection)
- **Phase III** Full Reconstruction (St. Anne's Church to Twelfth St. intersection, excluding Phase II area)

WORK PROGRESS (Last 2 Weeks)

- **Phase I** Complete.
- Phase II
 - Finalized drainage installation, roadway box-cut and installation of new gravels between Seventh St. & Eighth St.

Phase III

- Box-cut and installation of new gravels from Heritage St. to Seventh St.
- Continued concrete sidewalk installation from Eighth St. to Twelfth St.

WORK SCHEDULED (Next 2 Weeks)

Phase II

- Finish base pavement, curbing and concrete sidewalk installation from Seventh St. to Eighth St. in preparation for Brown School opening day.
- Improvements to the Twelfth St. intersection are beginning today. New drainage, gravels, pavement, curbing, sidewalks, signals and improvements to the north corner of the bridge are scheduled to be completed over the next 3 - 4 weeks.

Phase III

 Continue with concrete sidewalks and begin landscaping and concrete sidewalk pavers from St. Anne Church to Twelfth St.



MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

Detours from Iceland St. to Twelfth St. will be in place over the few weeks as paving, curbing and sidewalk improvements are completed. Sweden St. will primarily be utilized for detours starting August 28th as Brown School re-opens.

During construction in the Twelfth St. intersection, uniformed police officers along with flaggers will be utilized to control traffic. In addition, a truck route detour utilizing East Milan Road will be in effect during this duration to ease congestion at the intersection.

Please be advised, the Contractor plans to work Saturdays and possibly Sundays in order to meet proposed schedules moving forward.
