CITY MANAGER'S REPORT 10-02-2023

1. The airport sold \$17,825 in fuel in the month of September.
2. The salt shed location has been paved and the cement ballast blocks are being delivered and placed this week. The salt shed has a scheduled ship date of October 24th, construction should commence after its arrival.
3. New signs identifying the truck routes through the city have been installed at both ends of Main Street.
4. Preparations are occurring for the RiverFire event, staff will assist the Chamber staff in setting up for this well attended event.
5. Efforts continue city wide to address code compliance issues, specifically uninspected and unregistered vehicles and trailers improperly parked and stored on both public and private property.
6. There were 13 properties that were tax deeded this year. Of the 13, 2 have been repurchased and 2 are working with the Homeowner Assistance Fund to repurchase. Of the remaining properties 3 are vacant and secured, 1 is land only, 1 is a commercial entity and 4 are possibly occupied – we will be working to ascertain the occupied status of these 4 properties.
