## CITY MANAGER'S REPORT 10-02-2023

- 1. The airport sold \$17,825 in fuel in the month of September.
- 2. The salt shed location has been paved and the cement ballast blocks are being delivered and placed this week. The salt shed has a scheduled ship date of October 24<sup>th</sup>, construction should commence after its arrival.
- 3. New signs identifying the truck routes through the city have been installed at both ends of Main Street.
- 4. Preparations are occurring for the RiverFire event, staff will assist the Chamber staff in setting up for this well attended event.
- 5. Efforts continue city wide to address code compliance issues, specifically uninspected and unregistered vehicles and trailers improperly parked and stored on both public and private property.
- 6. There were 13 properties that were tax deeded this year. Of the 13, 2 have been repurchased and 2 are working with the Homeowner Assistance Fund to repurchase. Of the remaining properties 3 are vacant and secured, 1 is land only, 1 is a commercial entity and 4 are possibly occupied we will be working to ascertain the occupied status of these 4 properties.

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
