## CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

10-17-2022



1. The City's parking ban comes into effect on November 1. No vehicles shall be parked on City streets between the hours of Midnight and 7:00 a.m. Overnight parking is allowed in the parking lot adjacent to the Salvation Army.
2. Attached is the Fire Chief's September report, the Monthly Incident Report and the EMS call volume report.
3. This office has noticed that there are many instances of unregistered vehicles and trailers, equipment and items being parked or left on City streets. The police are being notified and have been taking action to correct this. There are many instances of trailers that are registered parked for long periods on city streets as well. Said trailers still need to adhere to parking restrictions regarding time, parking prohibitions and parking too close to a corner or intersection. At present there is no ordinance limiting or prohibiting the parking of detached trailers on City streets.
4. Progress is being made by staff and this office on the code and solid waste issues discussed prior. Education on this includes the solid waste policies allowing for residents to obtain a pass at City Hall for the disposal of bulky items and tires, both of which are an issue and not picked up by solid waste collection, per ordinance.
5. Vacant City lots are intended for passive recreation only, they are not to be used for parking, storage or dumping areas – staff has been asked to address and correct any instances where the above is occurring.
6. The flags requested for the Veteran's memorials have been ordered.
