CITY MANAGER'S REPORT 11-06-2023

- 1. Attached please find the BWW Municipal Water Usage from July 1, 2023 to October 1, 2023 (November 2023 Billing Quarter).
- 2. I had the opportunity to tour the Career Technical Education program classrooms at the high school. The programs offered and the learning spaces are impressive. The curriculum prepares students for careers in welding, mechanical engineering, woodworking, early childhood care, medicine / nursing and graphic arts. It is just as impressive that a community of this size is able to have such robust programming.
- 3. The traffic lights at East Mason and Hutchins Street have had a component fail. We are in the process of securing a replacement component. At this time this light should not be replaced completely it would make better sense to include an upgrade to this signal when the Main Street work is done, as the signal could coordinate and communicate with signals on Main and Pleasant street, making for more effective intersection and traffic flow management. No cost estimate on the component replacement is available yet.
- 4. As of this report, the new salt shed is almost complete, it may be finished later today. Strong winds delayed final completion this weekend.
- 5. As a reminder, the winter parking ban is now in place. In addition, residents should remove items from the right of way, including basketball hoops, trailers and other items stored in the road.
