## CITY MANAGER'S REPORT 6-5-2023

- 1. FEMA contacted the City regarding damage during the rain event in early May, the repair to the Hillsboro Street drainage was submitted for a potential reimbursement at this time FEMA is gathering damage estimates in anticipation of a federal disaster declaration.
- 2. Work continues on correcting ordinance issues on properties in the city, specifically in the areas of uninspected motor vehicles and unregistered items on the city streets. Some instances will need legal intervention to resolve.
- 3. Both vehicle and ATV traffic has greatly increased with the unofficial beginning of summer. The police department has been spending considerable effort in ensuring that both residents and visitors remain safe on the roads and on the trails.
- 4. Local volunteers have recently done a wonderful job in beautifying the downtown areas, Riverwalk, gardens and traffic islands. If and when we receive assistance from either the federal prison or court ordered community service we will use these people to assist in cleaning up roadside trash.
